
Activity 1 - hidden stories

This activity focuses on the urban space in terms of inequality, social justice, and marginalization.

It asks participants to observe the urban space, to connect with/identify all the situations that reflect unequal/unjust distribution of resources that result in the exclusion of certain members from social practices, opportunities, and from achieving their full potential.

Instructions:

- 1. Think about the surrounding urban space (or if you do not know it well, the one around your home, or one that you know quite well).
- 2.Represent the space (draw/use icons) and describe
 (post-its/writing):
- a. the main activities that characterize this space
- b. who is excluded from them
- c. why they are excluded
- d. what prevents their access to a specific activity
- e. what the other social actors are doing about it

Suggestions:

- You do not need to map a wide area, a few elements are fine.
- Focus on performing an in-depth exploration.
- Write notes on what you noticed (draw arrows and describe what is happening; use icons to explain or point out similar situations).
- Share and discuss your experience of the place with your partner. They can support you in writing everything down.
